- ❑ Conditions, sandy loam to heavy rock country
- ❑ Sowing speed, average 11km, slowing to 8-9km in heavy rock

- ❑ The Lock region of South Australia is extremely rocky and Jason and Lindsay have trialed all major types of knife points with little success.
- ❑ They were both extremely impressed with how the Discamate units rode over the rocks, rather than bring them up. It is the first year that rocks have not been a problem on their farm.
